Generally, in order to confer benefits of duty preference, local inputs must be at least 35% or appear in the appropriate Harmonized Tariff appendix. 'NAFTA' model free trade acts required non-originating articles to undergo a tariff shift or if not, meet a minimum regional value content. You must refer to the specific General note (GN) in the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States for a detailed explanation of qualification. .
