

PARTS OF GENERAL USE

The phrase 'PARTS OF GENERAL USE' is defined by Customs and Border Protection as the following:

- Tube or pipe fittings of iron or steel (7307)
- Stranded wire, rope, cables, slings etc., of Iron or Steel (7312)
- Chain and chain parts of Iron, Steel or plastic (7315)
- Nails, tack, drawing pins, staples of Iron, steel or plastic (7317)
- Screws, bolts, nuts coach screws, cotter pins etc. of Iron, Steel or plastic (7318)
- Springs and Leaves for springs of base metals or plastic (7320)
- Padlocks, locks, clasps, keys, etc (8301)
- Base metal or plastic mountings, fittings, hinges, brackets, grip bars, etc. (8302)
- Claps, buckles, hooks, eyes, for clothing, travel goods and other made up articles (8308)
- Sign plates, name plates, address plates etc. of base metal or plastic (8310)
- Non-electric bells and gongs, base metal statues, picture frames, mirrors etc. (8306)

Refer: Section XV, Legal note 2. In chapters 73 to 76 (except 7315) and chapter 82, references to parts of goods do not include references to parts of general use. Articles of chapter 82 or 83 are excluded from chapters 72 – 76 and 78 – 81.
