Casings	Any product containing animal by-products: bones, egg shells, fats, tallow, hides, leather, pet food, trophies (hunting), blood	<b><u>RULE OF THUMB:</u></b>  <b><i>IF IT CAME FROM AN ANIMAL- IT IS PROBABLY REGULATED BY USDA (AND MAYBE FWS) ANIMAL FEEDS, DRIED LEATHER ON DRUMS, MOTHER OF PEARL, FOOD ADDITIVES</i></b>
