Aluminum Content Derivatives Value Confirmation - Sec 232 Duties

Effective June 4, 2025, U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) began collection of the 50% import duty on certain imports of aluminum articles and derivative aluminum articles from all countries (UK remains at 25%). This additional duty is based on the value of the aluminum material in the product. If you are unable to provide the value of the aluminum articles that were smelted and cast in the United States the 232 duty rate is 0%. Effective June 28, 2025, if you are unable to determine the country of cast and smelt, CBP has directed that importers must report Unknown "UN" and pay a 200% duty instead of the 50% duty. Importers may submit a post-summary correction to update the country of smelt or cast when they obtain information on the actual country(ies) of smelt or cast.
