Steel Content Derivatives Value Confirmation - Sec 232 Duties	
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Effective June 4, 2025, U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) began collection of the 50% Section 232 duty on certain imports of steel articles and derivative steel articles from all countries (UK will remain at 25%). This additional duty is based on the value of the steel material in the product. If you are unable to provide the value of the steel content in the product, then the total value of the item will be subject to the additional 50% duty rate. If you are unable to determine the country of melt and pour for the steel, then Customs advises you may report OTHER for the country. For derivative iron or steel products processed in another country from steel articles that were melted and poured in the United States the 232 duty rate is 0%.
