

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is duty drawback?

A refund of up to 99% of customs duties, taxes, and fees paid on imported goods that are later exported or destroyed. This applies to unused merchandise, manufacturing materials, and rejected goods.

Who qualifies for drawback?

Importers, exporters, and intermediary consignees. CITTA ensures you can lay claim to eligible duties and no one else.

What documents are required?

Proof of import (entry summaries), proof of export (bills of lading), inventory records, and manufacturing evidence when applicable.

Which tariffs are eligible for drawback?

Drawback applies to Section 301, Section 201, the 2025 "reciprocal" tariffs, and many others. Exclusions include Section 232, IEEPA-based tariffs, and Antidumping/Countervailing Duties.

How long does it take?


Onboarding typically takes 60–90 days. During this time, CITTA files your privileges application with CBP. Approval usually takes 6–12 months, after which reimbursements begin.

How much is CITTA's fee?

Fees depend on program complexity and volume. You pay nothing upfront—CITTA only gets paid when you do.
